Dear Mr. Sperry:

In late 2015, an external candidate, Mr. Ntando Chuma, accepted a job offer for the Engineering Technician 1 classification. Mr. Chuma's first day of employment was November 23, 2015, and he was headquartered at the Applied Technical Services building in San Ramon.

Mr. Chuma was inadvertently provided a 2.5% pay increase, effective May 23, 2016. In February 2018, it was discovered that Mr. Chuma was in fact not entitled to this increase and changes were made retroactive to May 23, 2016. Therefore, Mr. Chuma received a significant overpayment.

Based on the circumstances specific to this issue, the Electric Operations organization proposes to absorb the overpayment for Mr. Chuma and not require any amount of the overpayment be returned.

This agreement is non-precedent setting and does not in any way prejudice the Company's rights to collect overpayments.

This agreement has been discussed with local Business Representative John Ward.
